Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi invites application from the eligible candidates for admission to **1st year of 3 year LL.B.** programme for the academic year 2025-26 at Affiliated Law Colleges of the University.

The admissions should be as per the Admission Calendar and Admission Rules of the University as given below.

Note: * one duly filled in application form with the seal of the respective Affiliated Law College and along with necessary documents shall be sent by the candidate to the Registrar, Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi- 25 on the same day of the submission of the application to the affiliated law college.

** The affiliated law colleges have to send the consolidated list on or before 13.08.2025, 1st merit list on or before 16.08.2025 and 2nd merit list on or before 30.08.2025. these lists shall necessarily bear the signature of Principal. These lists have to be sent to aracademic.kslu@gmail.com without fail.

*** The Affiliated Law Colleges shall compulsorily comply with the above admission calendar of events for the Academic year 2025-26.

**** The colleges are required to remit the admission fees of the students to the University on or before 08.09.2025 mandatorily.

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

➤ The applicant who has passed the prescribed qualifying examination from recognized University/Boards of examination that are situated outside Karnataka or in a Foreign country shall **compulsorily obtain** the ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE through (online) **Seva Sindhu portal** before taking the admission.

1. Candidates may apply for the Eligibility Certificates to the KSLU through online on Seva Sindhu web portal to the office of K.S.L.U., Hubballi along with original/attested documents of 10th, 12th Std & U.G., Degree marks card along with the transcripts issued by the concerned University or Board or Department. If the marks cards issued the universities are in grade systems (CGPA) then percentage conversion transcript / marks card have to be uploaded in seva sindhu web portal.
2. The Eligibility Certificate will be issued online by the University for those candidates who have obtained their qualifying degree/certificate from recognized Board / University situated outside the Karnataka state and all the foreign candidates/applicants.
3. The qualifying degree/certificates and marks cards should be in Kannada or English only.
4. All those candidates who have obtained qualifying degree/certificate from outside the Karnataka state should produce the countersigned original certificates from the issuing authorities/universities, otherwise eligibility will not be considered.
5. The students who have studied qualifying examination under CBSC Board, New Delhi or exempted from eligibility certificate for admission.
6. Fees for Eligibility certificate is as prescribed by the University.

Note:

Students have to apply for eligibility certificate through Seva Sindhu portal from 23.07.2025 to 13.08.2025.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

1. Instructions to the affiliated Law Colleges regarding the admissions to 3 year Law Programmes for the academic year 2025-26.

The applications for admission and the admission statement should be as per Proforma prescribed by the University. The duly filled in admission statements in **Proforma-1, 2 3 and 4**, shall be sent to aracademic.kslu@gmail.com in MS excel format

mandatorily on or before 08.09.2025. Admissions shall be made purely on **Merit cum Reservation Basis**.

The eligibility for admission is as given below:

A) 3 year LL.B programme :

- (a) An applicant who has graduated in any discipline of knowledge from a University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State Legislature or an equivalent national institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or Foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for **Three year degree** programme in law leading to the conferment of LL.B. degree on successful completion of the regular programme conducted as per KSLU Regulations.
- (b) **Minimum percentage of marks** in qualifying examination shall not be below 45% (44.5% and above shall be treated as 45%) of total marks in case of General category applicants, 42% (41.5% and above shall be treated as 42%) for OBC category and 40% (39.5% and above shall be treated as 40%) of total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.
- (c) **Maximum age** * for seeking admission is limited to 30 yrs (thirty years) in case of General category of applicants and to 35 yrs (thirty five years) in the case of applicants from SC, ST and Other Backward Communities as on 20.09.2023

Explanation:

An applicant who has passed the 3 years U.G. degree from Open or Deemed University recognized by & established under the UGC Act, after prosecuting the studies in the pattern of 10+2 at Secondary/Higher Secondary Schooling is eligible for admission to 3year LL.B programme.

The applicant who has passed the qualifying examination U.G. degree in a **single sitting** examination is not eligible for admission to 3 yr LL.B Law programme.

**A Writ Petition (civil) No. 1023/2016 is pending before the Supreme Court of India regarding the maximum age limit prescribed for admission. The admission of the students who have crossed the age limit is subject to the outcome of the said writ petition. In this regard, college has to obtain an undertaking from the students who have crossed the age limit in the proforma enclosed.*

3) ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- a) Admission to the programme shall be made strictly on the basis of merit cum reservation basis. While making admission to the course **reservation policy** of the Government of Karnataka governing admissions to higher educational institutions issued from time to time shall be observed strictly.
- b) The admission of the students has to be on the basis of Merit cum Reservation. The Reservation policy as notified by the Government of Karnataka has to be adhered to.

4) FEES

- a) All Principals are strictly instructed to collect the fees as prescribed by the University and Government of Karnataka.

- a) The college shall apply to District Social Welfare/BCM Department concerned for the reimbursement of SC/ST/OBC students fees.
- b) All the Principals are strictly instructed that if previous years admission fees have not been remitted to University fully then, present year admissions will not be approved at the time of Admission verification for the year 2025-26.

5) INTAKE

No College shall admit the students in excess of the sanctioned intake provided by the University and Bar Council of India.

6) THE COLLEGE AUTHORITY SHOULD STRICTLY VERIFY -

- a) The eligibility of the students should be as per BCI rules & KSLU admission regulations before admitting the students to the programmes.
- b) The students shall be asked to produce the Migration and Transfer Certificates within fifteen days from the date of admission.
- c) In case of applicants from Foreign Universities/Boards, the applicant should have obtained the valid passport, visa, Residential permit, and "Students Study Permission/NOC" from Foreign Embassies of both the nations. They should also obtain a certificate that the degree is obtained from a recognized Board/University from the embassy concerned in India.
- d) In case of applicants from Foreign Universities/Boards, the applicant shall be asked to produce the "Equivalence Certificate" issued by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi if necessary.
- e) At the time of documents verification by the University for admission approval, the college should submit the originals of above documents & 'Eligibility Certificate' (wherever applicable).
- f) The Principal of the college shall verify the original documents and attest the copies thereof.
- g) The Principal of colleges should certify that the admissions (for all classes) of course/s are made as per the admission rules of Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi and Government of Karnataka.
- h) In case a student is an employee either in State/Central/Private organization, he/she shall submit No Objection Certificate from employer concerned stating that the working hours do not conflict with college timings and the Principal should certify that the candidate is capable of attending 75% of classes.

7) THE COLLEGE AUTHORITIES SHALL ENSURE SUBMISSION OF THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS BY THE APPLICANT TO THE COLLEGE, AS BELOW.

- a) The Eligibility Certificate issued by the University, in case of Non-Karnataka and Foreign students at the time of admission.
- b) 10, +2 and U.G. Degree Marks cards of all years/Semesters & Passing certificate in case of **3 year LL.B.** admission at the time of admission
- c) The Transfer & Migration Certificates shall be submitted by student to the college at the time of admission or within fifteen days from the date of admission to the college.
- d) In case of SC/ST/Cat-1/OBC student, **Caste & Income certificate** shall be submitted by student to the college at the time of admission if they claim Fee Exemption.

- Soft copy Proforma No: 01 to 04 shall be submitted through email on 08.09.2025 after closing the admission dates as mentioned in the academic calendar 2025-26 aracademic.kslu@gmail.com
- Consolidated admission statement in Proforma No: 02 along with admission applications with necessary attested documents to be submitted at the time of original documents verification.
- The Proforma No: 02 to 04, of admission statements along with the covering letter (with details of fee paid) addressed to the Registrar, Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi, and be submitted at the time of original document verification .
- Incomplete information in the Proforma will be rejected and admissions of the college will not be approved or may be withheld for want of information.
- The serial numbers of candidates in subsequent admission statements viz, Proforma 2, shall be in continuation with the 1st list of admission statement.
- Admission statement in proforma - 2 should be prepared as per the date of admission serially, not in alphabetical order.
- Fees collected shall be remitted through online (SBI Collect). The admission statements and the fees paid details shall be submitted to the Registrar, KSLU along with the **Proforma No: 01** containing details of fees.

Note:

1) In complicated/doubtful cases, the principal of the college may seek clarification from the Academic Section.

2) The college/s shall admit the student/s only after verification of the necessary documents & eligibility certificate for fulfillment of eligibility criteria, as detailed in the K.S.L.U. Admission rules. In case any college admits in-eligible candidate/s to any course, the Principal will be responsible for further consequences in the matter of non-approval of such admission/s as per the University norms.

3) Proforma to be submitted have been restructured. New Proforma have been made available on the University website. The colleges are informed to fill the necessary details in the new Proforma.
